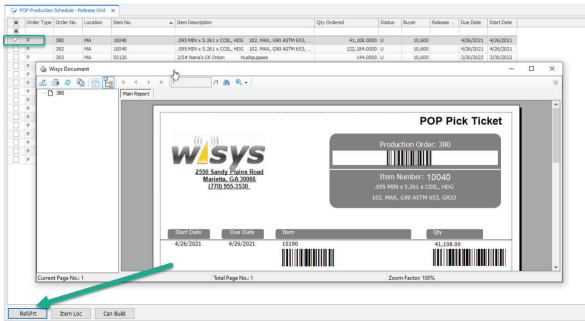

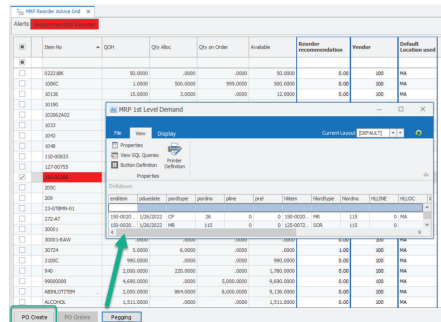

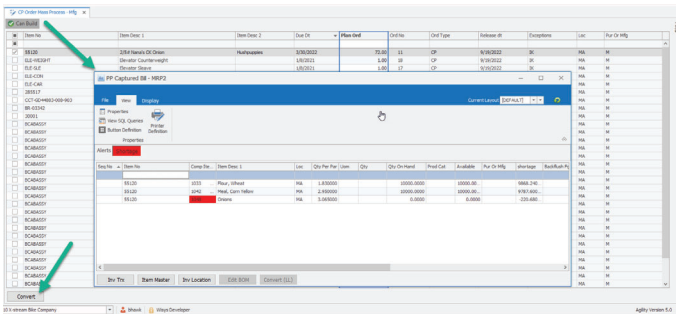

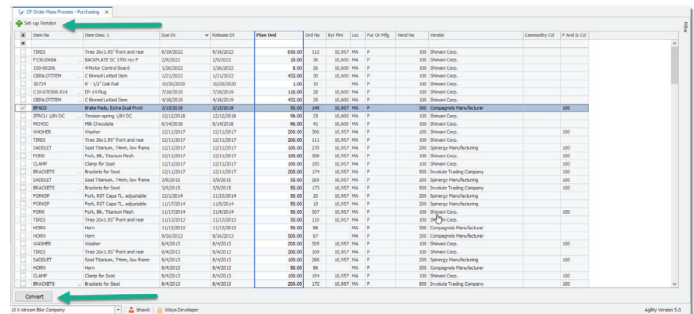
POP Production Schedule Release Grid



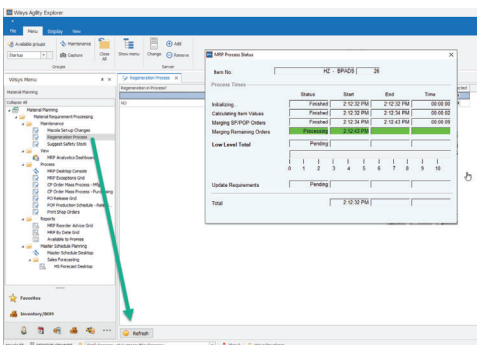

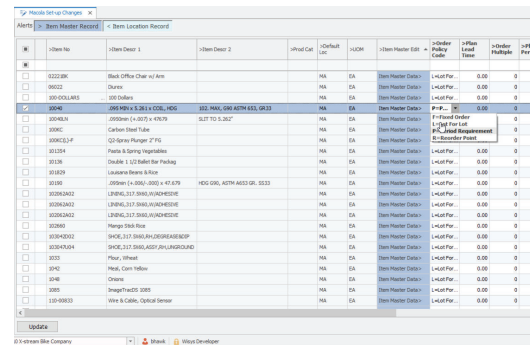
CP Mass Order Process (Manufacturing)
